AZRCHA Event Rules & Regulations:

1. Show facilities and stalls will be available beginning at noon on March 15, 2012. Please call Tim Lynch at 580-277-9003 or Tammy Kelly at 480-285-9331 to arrange for early arrival. Stall information can be obtained from the show office beginning on March 15, 2012. After hours, stall assignments will be posted on the show office door.
2. Entry Forms for the Futurity and Horse Show Entry **must** be postmarked by the designated entry deadline to avoid a late fee.
3. Cow Horse classes will be conducted according to the current rules of NRCHA and will run concurrently with AQHA Working Cow Horse classes. NRCHA equipment rules apply to concurrent AQHA and NRCHA entries.
4. Cutting classes will be conducted according to the current rules of AQHA/NCHA.
5. Current NRCHA membership for the Owner and Exhibitor is required to enter the NRCHA classes. Membership Application forms may be obtained at the Show Office or by visiting www.nrcha.com.
6. Current AQHA membership for the Exhibitor is required to enter the AQHA Working Cow Horse classes. Membership Application forms may be obtained at the Show Office or by visiting www.aqha.com.
7. In order to enter the NRCHA classes and for points to count toward 2012 year-end awards, the AZRCHA requires current AZRCHA membership for both the Owner and Exhibitor at the time of the event. In addition, to be eligible for year-end awards, a horse or horse and rider combination must have competed at least three (3) times in a given class in at least three (3) AZRCHA accredited shows during the 2012 show season. 8. Current AZQHA membership for the Exhibitor is required for points to count toward 2012 year end awards. Membership Application forms may be obtained at the Show Office or by visiting www.azqha.com.
9. Exhibitors in a NRCHA Non-Pro class must possess a current NRCHA "Non-Pro Status" card.
10. Exhibitors in an AQHA Amateur or Novice Amateur class must possess a current AQHA "Amateur status" card.
11. NRCHA entries that run concurrent with AQHA Working Cow Horse entries pay only one cattle charge and reserve only one head per run.
12. In order to facilitate the draw, entries must be submitted to the Show Office by 5:00 p.m. the evening before the class. Entries submitted after 5:00 p.m. will ride last.
13. Circuit awards will be awarded for cumulative high point scores for both days for NRCHA classes only.
14. A \$5.00 show processing/drug testing fee per horse per show will be collected from all Exhibitors showing in AQHA Working Cow Horse classes and forwarded to AQHA.
