Horseshoe Park & Equestrian Centre Rules & Information:

1. Out of state competitors *must* check in with the show office and provide current Coggins and health certificate *before* unloading livestock.
2. **Horses shall be washed in designated wash racks only, and shall not be washed in or near the barn area.**
3. A minimum of two (2) bags of shavings shall be spread in the stalls at all times. Shavings must be purchased from the stall manager. Contact Tammy Kelly at 480-285-9331 for more information.
4. Feed may be purchased off-site at San Tan Feed, 18543 E. San Tan Blvd., Queen Creek, AZ 85242, (480) 988-3456.
5. Alleyways shall be kept clear of equipment, excess hay, bedding, etc.
6. Heat lamps, space heaters and water trough heaters are not permitted in barn area. Only fluorescent light bulbs are allowed.
7. Exhibitors and/or owners are responsible for their own tack. Horseshoe Park & Equestrian Centre and the AZRCHA are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
8. Smoking is not permitted in the barn area or within 20 feet of a barn entrance.
9. Animals are not permitted to be tied to stall doors or stall fronts. Participants shall use hitching rails provided or horse trailers to tie horses.
10. Nothing shall be nailed or screwed to stall or barn walls.
11. Soiled bedding shall be disposed of in manure bins provided. Water shall be disposed of outside of the barn area. Drains are located at water spigots.

Horseshoe Park Overnight Camping Rules:

1. Visit Horseshoe Park's web site at www.queencreek.org or contact Tim Lynch at 580-277-9003 or Tammy Kelly at 480-285-9331 for RV camping information. RV parking with hookups for electric and water is limited to 20 only – first come, first served.
2. Arrivals no earlier than noon on March 15, 2012, departures no later than March 19, 2012. Early arrivals or late departures must make arrangements directly with Horseshoe Park & Equestrian Centre.
3. RV camping area is located on the north side of the Horseshoe Park.
4. Shower facilities are provided.
5. No sewage or gray water shall be disposed of on the premises.
6. Quiet time begins at 10:00 pm.
7. No fires or open flames are permitted on the premises.
8. Guests shall refrain from hanging lanterns on trees and shrubs.
9. The maximum stay shall be limited to the length of the event.
10. Vehicles shall not block roadways.
11. Guests shall keep their site clean and dispose of trash in refuse containers provided. No glass allowed.
12. The use of motorbikes, scooters and off-road vehicles in the campground is restricted to regular roadways for use in entering and exiting only. Drivers shall be at least 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license.
